

Christmas Stocking

- What you need:
 - A print out of the template available on the website
 - About 1m of fabric
 - Thread
 - Fur trim
 - Pins
 - Scissors
 - Iron
1. Print out the template and tape together. Cut out the template.
 2. Fold your fabric in half and pin the stocking template to the fabric. Cut around the template so that you have two pieces that are mirror images of each other.
 3. Use the template to cut out your fur trim
 4. Pin the stocking fabric pieces right sides together and sew around the sides and the bottom



5. Clip the curve of the stocking (the front of the ankle) with little snips. This helps it turn better without puckering.



6. Turn stocking the correct way out and press.
7. Fold the fur trim right sides together and sew along the short edge.



8. Turn the stocking inside out again and place the fur trim along the top edge of the stocking. Right side of fur trim to wrong side of stocking.



9. Sew a line of stitching along the top edge, attaching the fur trim, with a 1cm seam allowance.
10. Turn stocking right way out and fold down fur trim.
